FAFSA stands for **Free Application for Federal Student Aid**. Federal student aid can **help you pay for college**. Fill out the **free FAFSA form** to qualify for grants, work-study, and loans.




**Apply early**


FAFSA is available on October 1 each year. Funds are limited, so apply early!

**Create your FSA ID**

The first step: make a secure account on the [Federal Student Aid website](#)

**Set aside 30 minutes**

Collect the info you need. Then fill out the FAFSA in about 30 minutes.

**Complete your FAFSA now!**

Submit your application to receive money to pay for college.
